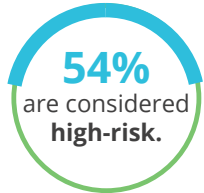

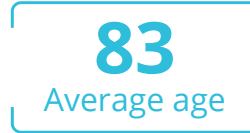

GROWING TRENDS AMONG THE ELDERLY

The most rapidly growing age group are those **age 85 and older**. Seniors are living longer, and the surge of “Baby Boomers” has just begun to arrive in that group. In 2025, VISTE received an average of 82 new client applications each month.

VISTE’s eldest client is 109 years of age. Not only are the elderly living longer, but **more than 90% want to age at home**. VISTE allows older adults (70 & above) to do that by providing essential services through the help of volunteers.
